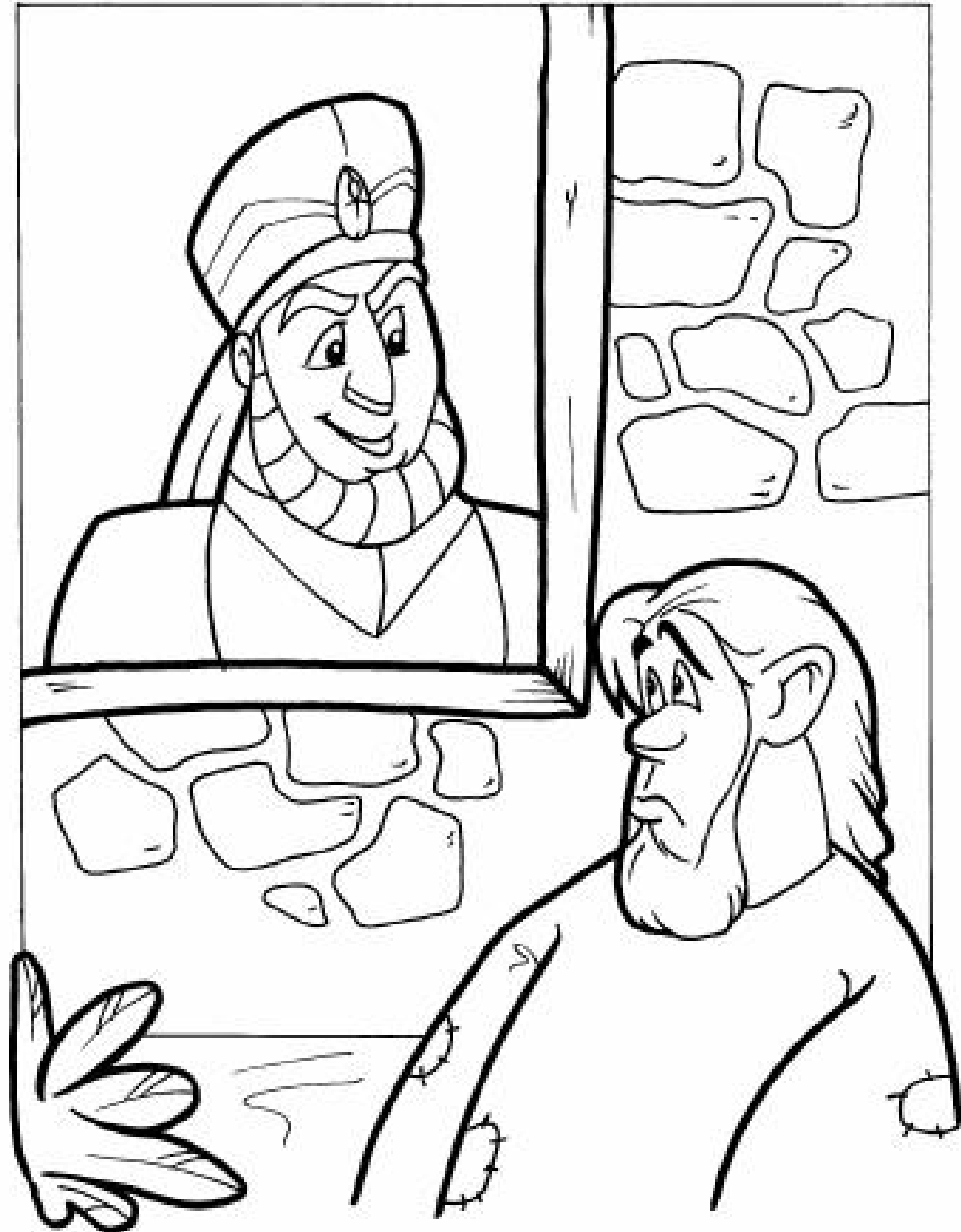

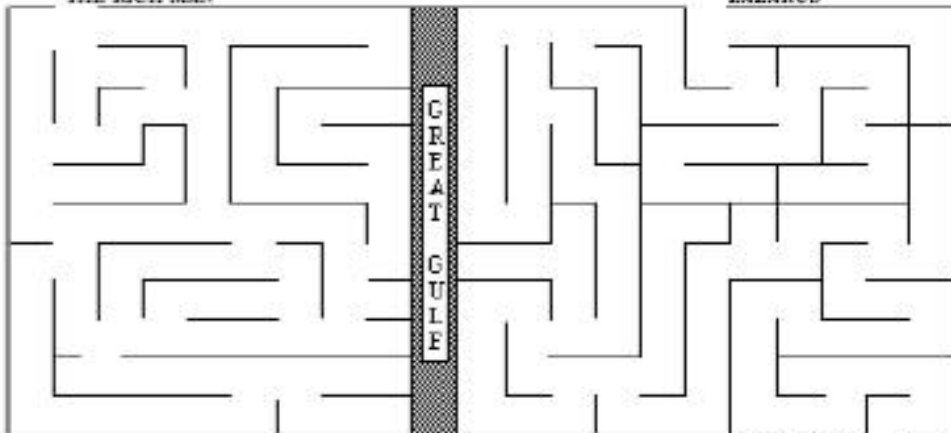

ABRAHAM

"There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen,
 and fared sumptuously every day: And there was a certain beggar named
 Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores," **LUKE 16:19-20**

2. "But there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, full of sores, who was laid at his gate." **LUKE 16:20**

CIRCLE THE CORRECT WORD:

3. "...desiring to be fed with the (**FEAST, CRUMBS**) which fell from the rich man's table. Moreover the dogs came and licked his sores." **LUKE 16:21**

TRUE OR FALSE:

4. "So it was that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died and was buried." **LUKE 16:22**

TRUE OR FALSE

"And being in torments in Hades..." **LUKE 16:23**

CIRCLE T FOR TRUE OR F FOR FALSE:

5. "...he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham afar off..." (v23) **T F**

"...and Lazarus in his bosom" (v23) **T F**

"Then he cried out, 'Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in the water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.'" (v24) **T F**

7. "But he said to him, 'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the (**BED, DEAD**).'" **LUKE 16:31**
